HAMPTON BEACH — Visitors to the Hampton Beach should note that parking meters cost 25 cents for ten minutes. The meters only accept American quarters - no other types of change will work. The meters are constantly monitored, and tickets are promptly issued to cars parked at expired meters. Alternative day-long parking lots with more modest fees are available at Hampton Beach along Ocean Blvd and Ashworth Avenue.
