# David Coffin performs at Sandy Point

STRATHAM | Folksinger David Coffin of the Boston/ Cambridge Revels will be performing on Sunday, September 24 at 4 p.m. at the Hugh Gregg Coastal Conservation Center at Sandy Point, located at 91 Depot Road in Stratham.

Coffin, who has been a lead singer, audience leader and instrumentalist for the Revels, will be performing to benefit the Great Bay Stewards and their programs.

A member of the Revels since 1980, Coffin has a repertoire which includes early music to traditional and contemporary folk music. He is regarded as one of the best and most renowned folk musicians of maritime songs of New England and Canada.

As music director, coordinator and singer for the Boston History collaborative harbor tours, "Boston by the Sea," he brought maritime history to life. His vocal and instrumental music was featured in the 2001 NBC

documentary, "Revenge of the Whale."

In August, Coffin was on a tour to the Canadian Maritime Provinces as guest performer aboard the "Carnival Victory." Some of his recordings include the new "Safe in the Harbour," "David Coffin and Friends," "The Nantucket Sleighride" and "Flight of Time."

Tickets for the concert are \$20 for general admission; children 12 and under, \$10; family, \$30; Great Bay Stewards members \$12; and Great Bay Stewards children 12 and under, \$8.
