
Come, bring your ideas and help us organize a special fun night.




## FRIENDS' 50<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY

## New Water Station Makes a Splash!


Lane Library patrons can now quench their thirsts at the new water station, a project that was funded by the Friends and led by Library Head of Adult Services Darrell Eifert.
