There will again be a raffle of a book bag filled with great books.

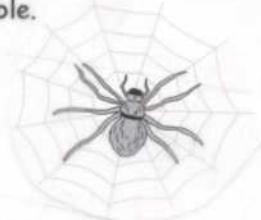
Volunteers are being recruited. Call the Children's Room at 926-4729 if you would like to help. Any one who volunteers is entitled to a free book from the titles available.

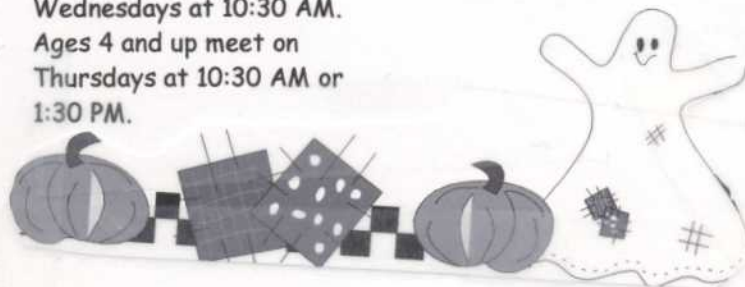
STORY TIMES
