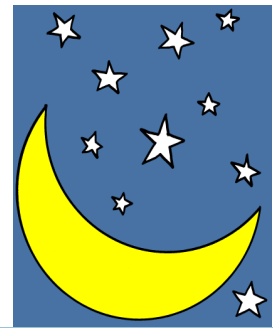




Dream Big READ!

Monday, June 18 launches our "Dream Big-Read!" Summer Reading Program.

How the Reading Program Works: Children keep a log of the hours they read (logs are available on our website and in the Children's Room beginning June 18). For every hour logged, the child gets a raffle ticket for our summer finale drawing. For every 2 hours logged, they will receive a paper star or moon to add to our summer wall display. When a child has read 3 hours, they can claim a mini prize from our treasure box.

All logs and raffle tickets will need to be completed and turned in by **12 pm, Wednesday, August 8 to be eligible for the drawing.**

Signups for the Summer Shows will open two weeks before each event. There is a legal limit on the number of people allowed in the venues at one time, so those on the list will be admitted before those who drop in.

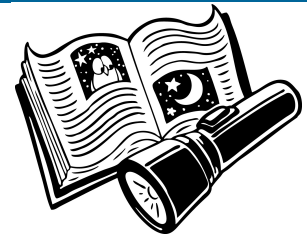
