

PRIZES AND REWARDS

Adults, teens, and children may pick up bookmarks at the library starting June 19th.

Liz has studied dances from Guinea, West Africa since 1995, after first being introduced to West African Dance as an undergraduate at Connecticut College. She's traveled to Guinea five times to dance and to learn more about many parts of the culture. Here in the US she has studied with several Guinean dance teachers including Youssouf Koumbassa. Thursday, July 27th, 6 PM

The Naval prison has been a fixture on a bluff overlooking the Piscatagua River adjacent to the Portsmouth Naval Shipyard in Kittery, ME for 114 years. Mr. Novello's presentation will be a combination of historic photos along with video clips from his documentary video anthology called, The Castle: Stories of the Portsmouth Naval Prison that chronicles the 66 year history of the Navy's only maximum security prison in the world where as many as 50,000 sailors and Marines spent time. The video clips cover three time periods starting with the end of World War 1; highlights the controversial Commander of the prison who brought scandal, prison reform, and a movie crew. There's 90 year-old footage of the prison from a silent Hollywood movie where Naval prisoners were used as extras. From the World War II era, Mr. Novello will show a video clip filmed in May 1945 which features rarely seen footage of captured German U-Boat crews escorted to the Naval prison. 
